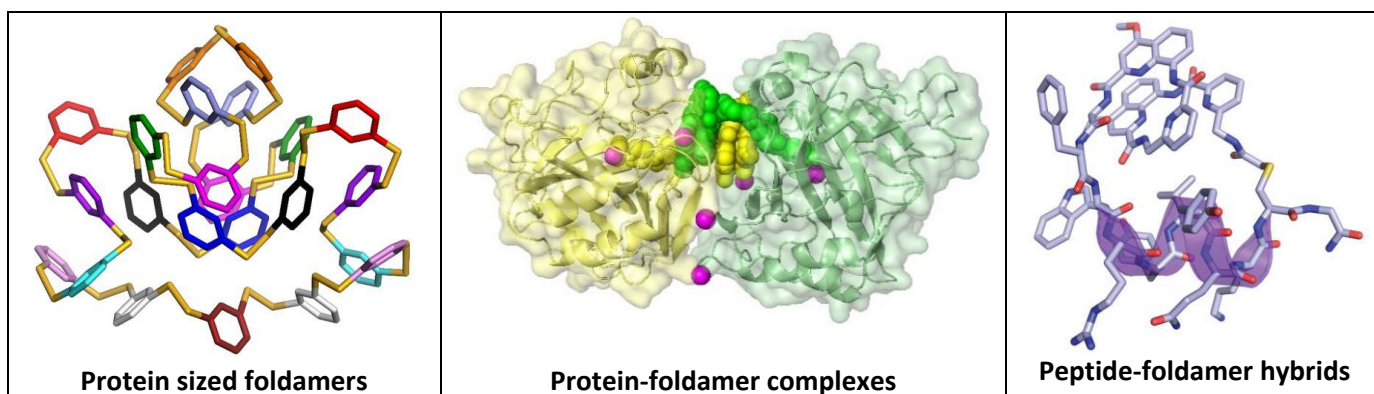


Post-Doc in Peptide/Foldamer/Protein Crystallography
